Day 1-2: Broome

On arrival in Broome you are met & transferred to your accommodation. Enjoy time at leisure to explore Broome.

The Pearle of Cable Beach

On Day 2 – Optional Camel Trek at Sunset along Cable Beach - \$95 per person



Day 3: Windjana Gorge

Begin our Guided Camping Safari. Visit the historic Boab Prison Tree then embark along the scenic Gibb River Road to arrive at our first campsite. Then experience a 750m cave walk through Tunnel Creek before sunset at Windjana Gorge for amazing photo opportunities. *Windjana Gorge*

Days 4-5: Mt Barnett Station/Manning Falls

Explore the ancient Devonian reef system that is Windjana Gorge. Enjoy viewing freshwater crocodiles & birdlife. Follow the Gibb River Road to the rugged King Leopold Range & into cattle country. Walk into breathtaking Bell Gorge for a swim. Arrive at Mt Barnett Station. Day 5 includes a walk into Manning Gorge to see ancient Aboriginal rock art & swim in clear pools near the Manning Falls. Enjoy a pleasant stroll into Galvan's Gorge. *Mt Barnett Station (2 nts)*

Day 6: Home Valley Station

Continue along Gibb River Road to Home Valley Station. Along the way visit the Gibb River, Durack River and Aboriginal art. Take in the awesome view of the Cockburn Ranges before arriving at Home Valley Station, a beautiful 'oasis' in the outback. *Home Valley Station*

Days 7-8: El Questro Station & Gorge

Make our way along Gibb River Road to the famous El Questro Station. Cross the Pentecost River and explore the stunning Emma Gorge.

Relax and explore the iconic El Questro township or enjoy an optional Champagne Chamberlain Cruise. Soak your body in thermal, crystal clear waters at Zebedee Hot Springs and explore the natural beauty of the El Questro Gorge. *El Questro Station (2 nts)*

Optional - Champagne Chamberlain Cruise -\$70 per person.

Days 9-10: Kununurra

Enjoy a relaxed morning then depart El Questro on a short drive to Kununurra, a unique town developed around the Ord River Scheme, Diversion Dam & agriculture. Take a walk into town and visit local art galleries. Your time is at leisure in Kununurra for optional activities. *Kununurra (2 nts)*

Optional - Scenic flight to explore Mitchell Falls – departs from El Questro & finishes at Kununurra – full day from \$1,090 per person

Days 11-12: Purnululu National Park & The Bungle Bungles

Travel to the World Heritage Listed, Purnululu National Park. You may consider a 'once in a lifetime' experience of an optional helicopter flight over the Bungle Bungles. The track into Purnululu National Park is for 4WD only.

Our slow but scenic trip is a great approach to the wonder of the Bungle Bungles. The Domes Walk, Piccaninny Creek, Cathedral Gorge and Echidna Chasm are on the 'list'. We are in the midst of the Bungle Bungles and there is almost too much to see and do. Bungle Bungle Station (2 nts)

Optional – Helicopter flight over Bungle Bungle from \$299 per person

Day 13: Fitzroy Crossing

Head south through some more incredible Kimberley landscapes. Travel to Halls Creek and a visit to the China Wall. Enjoy your final night camped by a billabong at an exclusive campsite. Sleep under a billion stars and to the sounds of the outback. *Fitzroy Crossing*.

Day 14: Broome

Start with a scenic river cruise exploring Geike Gorge. View the multi-coloured 30m high cliffs carved by the floodwaters of the Fitzroy River through the Devonian fossil reef before arriving in Broome. *The Pearle of Cable Beach.*

Day 15 : Depart

Transfer to the airport for your departure flight.
